No. 265-Edn (CS)/ OM-102L/2022 dated 24/04/23).
- It is to be noted that the applicants seeking admission to this college are strongly discouraged from coming to the college physically for any enquiry or for any other purpose from the beginning to the end of the admission process. ADMISSION REGULATIONS FOR SEMESTER WISE FOUR-YEAR B.A. / B.Sc./B.Com/BBA (Honours with or without Research) COURSES OF STUDIES UNDER [CURRICULUM AND CREDIT FRAMEWORK (CCF, 2022)]

- In exercise of the powers conferred by Section-54 of Calcutta University Act 1979, the University of Calcutta hereby makes the following Regulations for B.A. / B.Sc./B.Com/BBA courses of studies (under CCF, 2022).
- These shall apply to every **student** prosecuting the above Courses in this University.
- Notwithstanding anything contained in any other regulations or rules for the time being in force the study for the above Courses shall be guided by these Regulations effective from the Academic Session 2023-2024.
- Title and Commencement: These Regulations shall be called THE REGULATIONS FOR SEMESTER WISE 4 YEAR B.A./B.Sc./B.Com/ BBA DEGREE PROGRAMME under CCF, 2022 (CURRICULUM AND CREDIT FRAMEWORK), UNIVERSITY OF CALCUTTA.
- These Regulations shall come into force with effect from the academic session 2023-2024.
- Duration of the Programme: The B.A./ B.Sc./B.Com/BBA Programme shall be for a minimum duration of Eight (08) (with an exit option after completion of 2nd/4th/6th Semesters) consecutive semesters of Six months each, i.e. The odd semester will start ordinarily in the month of July and the even semester in the month of January of every year.

A student prosecuting a regular course of study for semester wise degree course shall have to clear all semesters in all respect within a span of <u>seven years</u> from the year of admission to the particular course and combination, failing which enrolment of the student shall stand cancelled.

Explanation: A student already admitted in this course may seek fresh admission with different course/ subject combination (with respect to Major/ Minor subjects) subject to eligibility criteria.

Applicability of the Regulations:

- These regulations shall be applicable to the students taking admission to the B.A. / B.Sc. Course from the academic session 2023-2024.
- Students who have already successfully completed any U.G. degree earlier are not eligible to take admission into above course

- A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent Examination is eligible to seek admission to the 1st year of the B.A./B.Sc. (Single-Major) Course of Studies provided the candidate has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100 and fulfills the conditions as follows
- Candidates are allowed to take admission in the session 2025-26, those who passed HS(10+2) or its equivalent examination 2022 onwards, i.e. 2022 to 2025
- Students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination or its equivalent from the All India Boards/Councils (i.e. CBSE, ISC and National Institute of Open Schooling) need not require to submit the Migration Certificate for getting Registration under this University.
 - For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the B.A./B.Sc./ (Single-Major) Courses, aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in top-four subjects in order of marks secured by a student. However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. However, if the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

Reservation Policy:

 Reservation Policy for admission shall be guided by the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission), Act, 2013 and the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Rules, 2014.

- According to the above-mentioned Act, SC/ST applicants will find their names listed in the General Lists
 according to merit as well as the lists for SC/ST. It is the choice of the candidate to be admitted EITHER
 as a General candidate OR as a SC/ST candidate against reservation.
- b. Scottish Church College being a Christian Minority Institution will also publish a separate list of Christian candidates (CNI and Churches Other than CNI) for admission.
 - There is a provision of 5% reservation for management discretion..
 - If an applicant is ST and Christian, College will not provide you this double benefit for admission. If a Christian applicant of Scheduled Tribe wishes to secure benefits in ST category, he/she should write NO in the space where he/she needs to specify whether he/she is a Christian. Otherwise the system will by default give preference to the Christian identity and consider the applicant as so. The applicant will lose his/her benefit as ST applicant in this case.

- II. Go to College website and click on the UG Admission 2025 button. Then click on the Online Admission Portal. Click 'Admission to UG Courses 2025-2026'.
- III. To start the registration/admission process applicants must have an active mobile number and an active email ID for online registration / application. These should be preferably their own as all future communication from the College will be on this number/ email id.

IV. Registration and Application Procedure:

Five (5) simple steps to be followed. Applicant must complete each step to proceed to the next.

Step - 1: Online Registration: The applicant needs to register by entering some basic information such as name, date of birth (DOB), gender, category, (own) mobile no, (own) email id etc. Then the applicant has to give a password of his/her own choice. Please note/save the password for later use.

Once this process is complete the applicant can review the information given by him/her and edit it if necessary. Once satisfied the applicant has to submit to complete the registration process.

On successful registration a **unique Student Id** will be generated. The applicant needs to note/save this unique Student ID as it will be used for subsequent log in purposes. Once submitted, data in the registration form cannot be edited.

Step - 2: Online Application: Once your registration is complete, please use the **Student ID, DOB and password** to log in to the application process as a registered applicant. Here you need to submit various kinds of information such as:

- Qualifying Examination Details
- Courses Applied Details
- Contact And Hostel Details

Once all inputs are saved, please enter the **security code** that would be visible and submit the application form. Once submitted, data in the application form cannot be changed.



- 3. After submission of the application form, the process is final and complete. Please note that after this no modification of data is possible. Please ensure that no mistakes are made during the process of filling up of the application form.
- 4. But, if an applicant wishes to apply for more than one Honours subject, he/she SHOULD fill in his/her choices in a SINGLE OR THE SAME APPLICATION FORM under the same Student ID before FINAL SUBMISSION of the form. Multiple subjects may be selected by adding to the APPLIED SUBJECT button in the form. In case the applicant already has made a final submission of one form for one subject, and then he/she wishes to apply for more subject he/she has to DECISTED area more and will receive a new.

wishes to apply for one more subject, he/she has to REGISTER once more and will receive a new Student ID for that.

5. - 7. Request for any correction will be entertained up to 24 hrs. from the time of publication of the provisional List. Any query/complaint received after this time will not be entertained.
- 8. The college will require **at least one day** to solve the possible issues raised by applicants.
- **9.** Following this a **Final Merit List** will be published on the college website. The college will not entertain any further complaint/query after the publication of this list.
- 10. The Admission process will then start with publication of Merit List for Admission. The Merit Lists will be published on the college website in regular phases, according to availability of seats in each stream and subject, and Calcutta University notifications. Regular notification in this matter would be put up on the college website. All concerned applicants are requested to check the college website REGULARLY (on a DAILY basis) for such information.
- 11. The applicants selected in the Merit List for Admission in all the phases of admission published on the college website will be informed through SMS and EMAIL
